Senior Checklist:

- Attend the Pinkerton **College Information Nights** for Seniors and Parents
 - 10/16 6pm NHHEAF FAFSA presentation in the Stockbridge Theater
- Visit** College Representatives when they come to Pinkerton Academy. Full list on Naviance homepage.
- Based on researched **Admissions Requirements** prepare a list of colleges
- Research **Application Requirements and Deadlines** for each school
- If need to retake, register for **SAT or ACT** at www.collegeboard.com and www.actstudent.org.
- If required, have College Board or ACT send out your scores to colleges
- If required ask teachers for **letter of recommendation(s)**
- If requested by teacher, complete a brag sheet or resume and give to teacher 30 days in advance of college deadline
- If required ask school counselor for letter of recommendation
- Complete and give brag sheet to your school counselor 30 days in advance of college deadline
- Complete college application via **Common App**, Coalition App, college website or as required by college
- Update **Naviance** (<https://student.naviance.com/pinkerton>) to add colleges and request letters
- Ensure Naviance is updated at all times to ensure materials are sent timely.
- Keep your school counselor informed of your progress

Financial Checklist:

- Fill out FAFSA forms on www.fafsa.ed.gov starting December 1st
- Fill out CSS profile if college requires it. www.collegeboard.org/css-fin
- Research and apply for scholarship
- Take a look at NH Charitable Foundation for potential scholarships <https://www.nhcf.org/>
- A great, free resource for financial information is **NHHEAF 1-800-525-2577**

- Await for college acceptance letters and financial award letters
- Compare award letters and calculate actual costs
- By May 1st, the National Candidate Reply Day, secure spot in incoming freshman class.
