

# Tips for Student Success!



## 1. UTILIZE ASPEN

- Grades and homework assignments updated regularly

## 2. TALK WITH OR EMAIL TEACHERS

- Communication is key. Always check in with your teacher when you need support!

## 3. AFTER SCHOOL EXTRA HELP IS AVAILABLE

- Teachers stay after school at least once a week to provide additional assistance to students.
- Please see individual teachers to determine the day they are available.

## 4. MATH CENTER OR WRITING CENTER

- Located in room 6- 226 in the Academy Building, the Math Center is open every period of the day with math teachers there to assist you during your study hall! You don't even need a special pass! The Math Center is open afternoons (except Wednesday) from 2:30-3:30.
- The Writing Center is located in room 403 in the Arts & Humanities building. It is also available during your study hall for when you need assistance with a writing project. You don't need a special pass for the Writing Center either!

## 5. LIBRARY & MEDIA CENTER

- You can get either a 15 minute green pass from your study hall teacher or check in to either location at the beginning of the period with your ID card.
- The Media Center is primarily for freshmen only!

## 6. IT'S ALL ABOUT ORGANIZATION!

- The student planner is a great tool to help you organize homework assignments and long-term projects. Use it! (Make sure you put your name in the front in case you lose it!)

- Plan to spend at least 2 hours on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights working on homework and long-term projects.
